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## Reading Aid

This representation of the questionnaire contains the same information as the portal panel-data.org.

Here, in addition to the *question number*, *question text*, *interviewer instructions*, and *answer options*, you find printed in green the *file name* and the *variable name* with the *variable label*, which contains information from the question. If you see rows of green lines below the answer option, the questionnaire defines several variables or information is stored in more than one dataset.

The *routing by filters* is depicted in blue.

Each variable is preceded by an identifier, which usually contains the question number and which is used when the variable is used in filters in subsequent questions. Such filters are usually placed as input filters (gatekeepers) at the beginning of a question. An identifier that is referred to in the input filter of a subsequent question is marked yellow as an example.

This reading aid does not cover a few exceptional cases: If the filter (as gatekeeper) only affects one of several variables for a question, the filter is printed in blue behind the variable. There you will also find a "go to" command in the form 2 @ Q73. Here, the questionnaire skips to question 73 if answer 2 was given.

Phrases that are not already translated in English are displayed in German and preceded by [de].

## **About this Questionnaire**

This questionnaire contains all questions from wave 2 (W2) of the German Social Cohesion Panel (SCP). The survey took place from September 5, 2022, to January 5, 2023. It targeted so-called anchor persons (AP), who were initially randomly drawn from population registers, their additional household members (HM) over the age of 18 they had previously named, as well as new household members (NHM) over the age of 18 named by the anchor persons in this wave.

The questionnaire consists of several sections. All respondents received an individual questionnaire. For NHM, this included some additional questions on biographical and unchanging sociodemographic characteristics due to their recruitment to the panel. Anchor persons additionally received a household questionnaire.

The survey was conducted as a mixed-mode survey (PAPI and CAWI). In addition to the German questionnaire, respondents in the CAWI mode also had an English-language questionnaire available. Question-specific differences in the questionnaire presentation between the two modes are listed in this document under the respective question.
