#### **German Social Cohesion Panel**

Established in 2021, the German Social Cohesion Panel (SCP) is a wide-ranging representative longitudinal study of private households in Germany, carried out in collaboration of the Research Institute Social Cohesion (RISC) and the German Socio-Economic Panel (SOEP).

The aim of the SCP Documentation is to thoroughly document the survey's data collection and data processing.

## 1 General Information

The PPATH dataset is designed to support longitudinal analysis linking personal information from various waves of the SCP. Each person participating in at least one survey wave is also in PPATH. PPATH also contains two persons who began the recruitment survey but did not answer any items and are excluded from the P, PGEN and PHRF datasets.

In some places in the documentation and in the data, year numbers are used, for example, for the names of variables and of the questionnaire instrument. These year numbers are always based on the field start of the data collection of the corresponding survey wave.

Data in this dataset may be missing due to different reasons. Missings are coded "[-1] No answer" if the respondent fails to provide valid information that is required for the variable. Missings are coded "[-2] Does not apply" if the information is missing due to the study design.

This identifier groups individuals into their original households at the start of the panel. That means, a person's CID is time-constant and will always relate them back to the household they initially belonged to, even if they moved out since.

This variable's information is based upon POTHCOUNT and PORIGIN. Respondents who were '[1] Born in Germany or immigrated before 1949' (GERMBORN) are assigned the value '[276] Germany'. If information about the country of birth is missing and GERMBORN is '[2] Immigrated after 1948' valid information about a respondent's citizenship (PNATOTH) is used to generate CORIGIN\_SCP. For individuals with the value '[-1] No answer', no valid information could be generated.

This variable provides information on migration background. It considers the country of birth and citizenship of the individual and his/her migration history. Direct/indirect migration background indicates whether the respondent immigrated by him/herself or has a non-German citizenship (direct migration background) or if she/he is of migrant origin but born in Germany (indirect migration background). Respondents assigned the code 4 also have a migration background, but we do not know whether they immigrated by themselves because the information on their country of birth is missing. Code '[1] No Migration Background' includes respondents of German nationality born in Germany whose parents and grandparents were also born in Germany. For individuals with the value '[-1] No answer', no valid information could be generated, mostly due to missing information on the parents' or grandparents' country of birth.
